

The SD91 Indigenous Education Department is starting an after-school program for Indigenous girls at our Muriel Mould Neighbourhood Learning Center building in November. We have conducted research at LDSS with Indigenous girls over the past year and have used that information to develop programming based on their needs. The program will be called Hundiyyhin. It is a Nedu'ten term used to describe brilliant women and translates to *sharp like a knife*. If you are receiving this your child has expressed interest in this after-school program. The program will run Tuesdays for Grade 8-9 and Thursdays for Grade 10-12 students. Please review the attached program description and permission form and return to the school by Tuesday morning. We will be having an open house on November 1st to have the girls visit the program center and be introduced to the staff that will be overseeing the program.
